Feel the history around the model of the first glass-house stage, where in 1912 the first Babelsberg movie was made. Our guide will share with you the most interesting tales from the Studio's past.

Get to know the state-of-the-art film studio, which is today the industry's leading service provider for film and television production and offers exceptional services to German and international producers. Oscar-winning movies like THE PIANIST, THE CONSTANT GARDENER, THE COUNTERFEITERS, THE READER, Quentin Tarantino's INGLOURIOUS BASTERDS, and Roman Polanski's THE GHOST WRITER were all filmed at Studio Babelsberg.

We will try to give you the best possible insight into the world of filmmaking on the tour but please keep in mind that, in general, actual movie sets are completely closed to visitors.

We offer the 90-120 minute guided studio tours to **adults (aged 18+)** in **groups of 8 to 25** people. The tours in German or English are available from **Monday to Thursday** (except for holidays) in the time from **9 am to 2 pm**, on request only. Please note that we cannot put individual visitors into groups and therefore can only allow **organized groups** to take part in the tours. Studio Babelsberg Tours take place **from April to October**.
